REGISTERING TO VOTE

WHO MAY REGISTER

To register in Texas you must:

- be a citizen of the United States
- be a resident of the county in which the application for registration is made
- be at least 17 years and 10 months old (you must be 18 to vote)
- not be finally convicted of a felony. (Felons regain the right to register when pardoned, after receiving a certificate of discharge from the appropriate correction institution, or after completing probation.)
- not have been declared incompetent by final judgment of a court of law.

HOW TO REGISTER

Get an application at any drivers' license bureau or post office, or contact the Voter Registrar or the League of Women Voters of Arlington. Applications may be requested on-line at the Sec'y of State's website (www.sos.state.tx.us).

REGISTERING TO VOTE (CONT.)

WHEN TO REGISTER

- Applications are accepted any time.
- Application must be received 30 days prior to an election in order to vote in that election.

WHERE TO VOTE

- During **early voting**, you may use any polling place. (Locations are published in local newspapers during the early voting period* and on election day.)
- On **election day**, vote at the site assigned to your precinct.
- Call the League of Women Voters of Arlington or the Elections Administrator for polling sites.

*Early voting period begins 17 days before and ends 4 days before an election.

IF YOU MOVE

If you move contact the Elections Administrator at least 30 days prior to an election for instructions.

HOW TO VOTE BY MAIL

You may apply for a ballot by mail if you:

- will be away from your county on Election Day and during early voting;
- are sick or disabled;
- are 65 years of age or older on Election Day; or
- are confined in jail.

Applications for a ballot by mail must be submitted to the Elections Administrator on or after the 60th day before Election Day and before the close of business on the 7th day before Election Day. This is not a postmark date--the application must be in the hands of the Elections Administrator by the 7th day before the election. Be sure to read the instructions on the application carefully.
